



About the Anthony D. Turner Scholarship:

Anthony Darryl Turner (October 10, 1961 - November 2, 2022) was an American basketball, football, track and field athlete who attended Central High School in Cheyenne Wyoming. In 1980, during his senior year, he showcased exceptional talent, earning All-State honors in football and basketball while securing State Championship in the 400 and triple jump. He was an avid participant in leading his basketball team to State Championships. He also participated on championship teams in football and track and field.

With his athletic accolades in hand, he would become the first black athlete, male or female, to be awarded the Milward Simpson Award. The Milward Simpson Award is considered the most prestigious award an athlete can earn in their high school career and is awarded to the most outstanding male and female high school seniors in the state of Wyoming.

In honor and loving memory of Anthony Darryl Turner, the Anthony D Turner Scholarship will be awarded to students (See application for details) enrolling in a Historically Black College and University (HBCU) and majoring in a Science, Technology, Engineering, or Mathematics (STEM) degree program in the fall of 2026.

The Anthony D. Turner Scholarship Purpose:

This scholarship was organized in memory of Anthony D. Turner to support community objectives that create positive change, give back to Historically Black Colleges and Universities (HBCU) and ensure that students desiring to attend an HBCU have assistance to pursue their educational aspirations.

What is the Amount of the Scholarship?

The recipient(s) will be awarded \$500.00 - \$2,500.00 upon receipt of enrollment at an HBCU majoring in a STEM degree program.

Who Can Apply?

- Students enrolling in an HBCU and majoring in a STEM degree program in the fall of 2026.
- Minimum grade point average of 3.5.

Who Cannot Apply?

- Prospective applicants who are related to Anthony D. Turner directly or indirectly are **NOT** eligible for the Anthony D. Turner Scholarship.
- Applicants who have received an Anthony D. Turner Memorial Scholarship award or an Anthony D. Turner Scholarship are **NOT** eligible for this scholarship.
- Family members directly or indirectly related to the Anthony D. Turner Scholarship board members are **NOT** eligible for this scholarship.

How Do I Apply?

Students must submit a completed application packet, to include:

- A completed Application form
- For high school students: An official letter (Stamped or sealed) from a school counselor, along with a signed letter from a parent or guardian granting permission to post the awardees in agreement with posting the awardees name and photograph on social media platforms.
- For college students: A signed letter in agreement with posting the awardees name and picture on social media platforms.
- Signed letter(s) and contact information from the volunteer organizations where community service participation occurred.
- For high school students: An official Transcript (Stamped or sealed and signed by a school counselor with contact information.)
- For college students: An official sealed transcript.
- An official picture ID from your educational institution
- Two letters of recommendation. The letters are to be written by;
 1. A present or former teacher, professor, counselor, or administrator (Official stamp or sealed)
 2. A character letter from non-relative
- One essay completed as follows (See application for essay titles):
 - The Essay shall be typed,
 - 350 words Minimum
 - Double spaced
 - 12-point font

April 1, 2026 is the deadline for submitting a completed application and supporting documentation. The Application must be in the Anthony D. Turner Scholarship PO box by the due date to be considered. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Scholarship recipients will be notified in May 2026.

Scholarship awards will be made at the sole discretion of the scholarship board.

The scholarship recipients must be willing to be present at the virtual awards ceremony to receive their award.
